The Pasfield House has hosted parties for a few discerning guests, plus private gatherings for up to 200.

George Pasfield, who assisted Abraham Lincoln in having the state capital relocated from Vandalia to Springfield, first owned the Georgian-style mansion during the 19th century. Today, Pasfield House is used as a temporary residence for lobbyists and state legislators, but primarily for gala functions.

Located just west of the Illinois State Capitol, the house has been used for weddings, anniversaries, intimate parties and backyard barbecues.
